You might have noticed a little image of Paris on Brookfield's Main Street Fabric Shop. Owner, Laura Carr, is also the Chambers secretary since she joined our group two years ago. Laura got involved with the Chamber in May of 2022 once her store opened. She wanted to help make Brookfield a better town to visit and hopefully also make folks feel this town could be their hometown too. Quilting is a great hobby and this type of business brings in a lot of quilting ladies from across Missouri and other states. She has had customers as far as Australia and England. The busy time for Fabric Chateau is during Sept and Oct when the All-Missouri Quilt Shop Hop is taking place. Quilters obtain an "Passport" from the "shop hop" magazine then they travel to all the Missouri participating quilt shops get their passport "stamped". This two-month shop hop brings in at least 800-1000 shoppers into this town. These folks also enjoy discovering the other retail and restaurants we have to offer in Brookfield.

Fabric Chateau mainly carries 100% cotton fabrics along with some soft flannel, new sewing machines to purchase and some quilting notions one might need when quilting. Laura also holds classes for the beginner or advanced sewest.





The Linn County Health Department is here to promote and protect the health of our community through public health initiatives. Public health is special because we focus on preventing disease and illness, through policies, programs, and education. We serve all residents of Linn County; we are here to serve our community as a whole. The Linn County Health Department offers the WIC program for our county. This is a supplemental nutrition education program that gives free groceries, personalized nutrition education, breastfeeding support, and more to those who qualify. Women who are pregnant, women who are postpartum, infants, and children up to the age of five are eligible if they meet income guidelines and are residents of the state of Missouri.

We offer public health nursing services, which include blood pressure checks, medication set ups, injections, blood draws, and immunizations. For injections and blood draws, doctors orders are required, but we hold a low-cost blood draw without a doctors order, once per quarter. We are your community experts in immunizations, helping everyone in your family stay up to date, including childhood immunizations, back-to-school immunizations, and adult immunizations, like flu, tdap, and covid vaccines.

Public Health keeps our community safe and healthy by offering restaurant and lodging inspections, making sure the places you eat, and where company rests their heads, are safe and meet health codes.

Beyond offering health services, we are your go-to spot for health education. We offer CPR classes and skills check-offs, safe sitter classes, child care consultant services, and more. We can attend your event or come speak to a class to help educate your group about a wide-variety of health topics, just call to inquire. We can offer health and safety presentations and written material as requested to continue to help promote health within our community.
